This report is adapted from Crime in South Carolina 2022 and showcases the Group A offenses of Murder, Sexual Battery, Aggravated Assault, and Simple Assault through the scope of intimate partner violence. All crimes included in this analytical report are categorized by an intimate relationship between the offender and victim. An intimate relationship includes spouse, ex-spouse, common-law spouse, boyfriend/girlfriend, cohabitants, ex-cohabitants, child in common, and ex-relationship.

Intimate Murder and Nonnegligent Manslaughter

South Carolina defines murder as the willful (nonnegligent) or intentional killing of one person by another. It includes deaths due to injuries received in a fight, argument, quarrel, assault, or during the commission of another crime. Suicides, traffic fatalities (including those involving DUI and Reckless Driving), fetal deaths, attempted murders, and accidental deaths are not classified as murder in terms of uniform crime reporting; therefore, they are not reflected in the data presented under this section. The classification of murder is based on the initial police investigation, not on the determination of a court, medical examiner, coroner, jury, or other judicial body.




Murder by Month and Time of Day (Night 6:00pm-5:59am; Day 6:00am-5:59pm)




Murder Victim to Offender Relationship










Intimate Sexual Battery

Sexual battery is the penetration—no matter how slight—of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, including oral penetration by the sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim. Based on this definition, sexual battery encompasses the crimes of rape, sodomy, and sexual assault with an object. The key element for all three of these sex offenses is the absence of consent. This includes situations where the victim cannot legally consent due to their age or mental/physical incapacity, whether temporary or permanent.


Victim Sex (Male, Female)




Victim Age (Male, Female)








Male Victim to Offender Relationship




Male Victim - Sexual Battery Type by Age








Sexual Battery Victims by Month and Sex




Sexual Battery by Location

Intimate Aggravated Assault


Aggravated assault is an unlawful attack by one person upon another where the offender uses a serious weapon, displays that weapon in a threatening manner, and/or the victim suffers apparent severe or aggravated bodily injury. A serious bodily injury may include broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, loss of consciousness, etc. A 'serious weapon' is defined as anything that could cause an injury that would typically require some form of medical attention. An injury does not need to result from an aggravated assault if a weapon is being used with the potential to cause a serious personal injury.





Agg Assault Victim to Offender Relationship



Agg Assault Type of Injury











Firearm Type

Intimate Simple Assault

Simple assault is an unlawful physical attack by one person upon another in which no serious weapon was used or displayed, and the victim did not sustain any serious bodily injury. If either of those elements does exist, the assault is considered an aggravated assault, not simple. Simple assault can include offenses such as minor assault, hazing, assault and battery, and any injury caused by culpable negligence.


Simple Assault Type of Injury (Minor Injury, No Injury)
